5. Cookies

ASP.NET_SessionId

Used to know the user through the entire visit on the website. The cookie is not saved after the user leaves the website.

MultiNodeTreePricker

Saves configuration information for the existing MultiNodeTreePicker data type. MultiNodeTreePicker is a tree structure used in Umbraco. The cookie is not saved after the user leaves the website.

UMB_UCONTEXT

Storing a reference for the user who is logged in. Being randomly generated at login and is used to gain access to the user without storing specific user information. The cookie is stored for 1 day after the visit.

Google Analytics

Google Analytics stores several different cookies on your machine, they collect data about the traffic on the site, such as which pages and items are visited most frequently by users. Front-safe uses statistics from Google Analytics to improve the usability of our site.

6. Use of personal data

Personal information is never disclosed to third parties, unless you express consent, and we never collect personal information unless you have given us this information at registration, purchase, or participating in a survey, etc. The type of information collected is name, address, zip code, email, gender, age, interests, attitudes and knowledge of various topics.

Personal information is used to complete a purchase or service. The information is also used to get more familiar with you and other users of the website. These uses may include studies and analysis aimed at improving our products, services and technologies; and displaying content and advertising that are customized to your interests and hobbies.

Protection of personal data

According to the Personal Data Protection Act, personal information is kept secure and confidential. We store your personal information on computers with limited access that are located in controlled facilities, and our security is checked regularly to determine whether our user information is handled securely, and always bearing in mind your rights as a user. We can not guarantee 100 percent security for data transmissions over the Internet. This means that there may be a risk that unauthorized persons gaining access to information when data is sent and stored electronically. Thus submitting your personal information is at your own risk.

To the extent that personal information about you are being processed, you are under the Personal Data Protection Act and have the right to obtain information on which personal data can be attributed to you. If it turns out that the information or data processed about you is incorrect or misleading, you are entitled to claim these corrected, deleted or blocked. You can always object to any processing of information about you. You can also at any time revoke your consent.
